LESSON OUTLINE

Today, and over the next few weeks we will be learning about Jesus and His amazing miracles. A miracle is an AMAZING event- often we don't understand how they happened. Today's lesson is about Jesus calming a BIG storm.

BIBLE REFERENCE- Jesus calms the storm
Mark 4: 35-41



LESSON OBJECTIVES

1. Jesus is calm when things go bad.
2. We can trust that God is in control even when things get crazy.

INTRODUCTION

Have you ever been afraid. I'm sure we have all been afraid at some point...the Bible tells us that God wants to protect us and keep us safe even when we're scared and anxious, which is another way of saying worried or afraid. Let's see what scared, worried, and

anxious look like. If you think you can put a scared look on your face, show your family your scared face. Now show your family a worried face.

God wants to take away those scared and worried looks and give you calm and peaceful faces. Now show your family a calm, peaceful face. I'm sure you look great—just the way God wants you to look all the time! And you can look that way by believing that God will never leave you—even when things are scary. Promises in God's Word tell us that God will never leave us.
