LESSON OBJECTIVES

2. It is good to share.

INTRODUCTION

Carry out this cool activity. Make sure you are very careful with scissors!

You'll need:

- paper
- 1 pair of scissors for each small group

Jesus did some amazing things when he on earth. Once, he took a small boy's lunch, just some bread and fish, and use it to feed over 5,000 people.

Look at your piece of paper, how many corners does it have?

Your paper has four corners. But what if you cut off a corner and give it to someone? Cut off a corner of the paper, and give it away. Now that you've given a corner away, how many corners do you have?

Do you have five?

Cut off another corner, how many do you have now?

Cut off another one, how many?

Keep going as much as you want!

You see, the more times Jesus divided the bread and fish, the more he had to give away. Not only that, the people had more than enough.

Did anything surprise you about that activity?
What do you have that you could share with others?
