BIBLE REFERENCE Acts 10



LESSON OUTLINE

Today's lesson is about Peter. The last time we learned about Peter, he was going to the temple. He was with John and they met a lame man. With God's power the man was then able to walk. Do you remember the story?

Today Peter and a man called Cornelius both hear from God. They listen to what God says and then do what he commands. Peter goes to Caesarea to teach Cornelius' friends about God.

LESSON OBJECTIVES

- 1. To know that God wants us to listen to Him.
- God accepts everyone no matter who they are or what they have done
- 3. It is important for us to follow God's ways

INTRODUCTION

Spend some time talking about people who may be different from you. For example - living in different places, looking different, eating different food and speaking different languages.









Today we are going to learn about Peter when he goes to visit Caesarea to teach about God and how he loves everybody.
