

# **INTRODUCTION**

Think about the different ways we use water both inside and outside our homes.





Now think about how we use water at church (not just at our snack time!) In our church, water is used by the minister and sprinkled on a child's head (usually a child) at baptism. In some churches it is adults who are baptized in water. When the minister baptizes them, they go under the water and come back up again!

Water is really good at getting things clean. By using water to baptize we remember that Jesus can wash all our sins away. When we are baptized as babies or children in our church, we believe that it is a sign of God's grace to us and that we have a special place in God's family. Our parents make special promises to God and the people in the church make a promise too, to help us learn more about God and to follow Him.

#### LESSON CONTEXT

Last week we learned about Jesus going to the temple in Jerusalem with His earthly parents. Today, and over the next few weeks we continue learning about Jesus and His amazing life on earth. Today's lesson is about Jesus being baptized in the River Jordan by his cousin, John.

BIBLE REFERENCE- Jesus is baptized by John (John the Baptist) Luke 3 v 1-22



#### LESSON OBJECTIVE

To know that baptism is a special sign (using water) to show that we are part of God's family




#### MEMORY VERSE

Numbers 6 v 24: The Lord bless you and keep you.

When anyone is baptized in our church, the whole church family sings a special blessing (part of it is in the memory verse above). The blessing was given to Moses from God and was to be spoken over God's people (the people of Israel) by Aaron (Moses' brother) and

his sons. Here is the whole Aaronic blessing:


