Farmyard Prayer

Pray with your family. It can be a farmyard prayer, just like Kids Church. Use a farm animal noise of your choice to tell the next person to pray.

Paper Airplane Races: Create and decorate a paper airplane and race with your family.

Introduction to Material

Over the course of nine weeks, Kids Church will be focussing on the Fruit of the Spirit, found in Galatians 5:22-23.

The Fruit of the Spirit shows us how God can work in us. There are nine different qualities listed in Galatians 5:22-23 that make up the fruit that the Holy Spirit can create and develop in us. For nine weeks, we are going to learn from Galatians 5:22-23 to see what it teaches us about God and what that means for our life. Ask: What does goodness mean?

Memory Verse

"But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Against such things there are no law." Galatians 5:22-23 (NIV)

Quick Fire: Grown-ups can read the verse twice and then asks the children if they remember the fruit order.

Bible Story

Goodness: The Good Samaritan – Luke 10:25-37

Key Points: - We need to stand up for what's right

Jesus defended the sick, poor and so much more

Loving your neighbour is living out goodness

Object Lesson

Play Steven Woods' video and talk to the kids about living out goodness. Your booklets are in Church but use a piece of paper to draw/write how you are going to live out goodness this week. Bring it to Kids Church and it can be glued into your booklet. Pray to close.
