Bible Story:

"Building Your Faith" is the series that Kids Church are going to focus on for the month of June! This session will be focussed on reading your bible. This is an important way to build your faith and learn more about God. Watch the video below and read Acts 8:26-40.

In this story, the Ethiopian man was eager to learn more about God by reading the book of Isaiah (which we can find in the Old Testament of the bible). Whenever he says that he

does not understand, Philip explains it to Him. We see that the Ethiopian man is eager to learn more about God and spend time in His word because he asks questions to Philip. Why is this important to us? It's important because we build our faith by not only reading the bible, but understanding what it says. In Kids Church, we often remind you to bring your bibles with you because we want you to read along when we read the stories to you. We want you to focus on the words and ask us questions because we want your faith to grow. The bible can look like a big intimidating book to read, but there are lots of stories that will help you to learn more about God. When you read the bible, it isn't a race to the finish line. When you read your bible, take time to ask your parents or family questions. If you have questions for us, let us know. You could write them down to remember them.

We are giving you a big challenge this week! We want you to pick your favourite bible story (if you can't think of one, ask your family if they have one). We want you to spend time reading the story and asking questions about it to help you build your faith!

Craft:

The craft today is a scroll that you will be able to put your favourite bible story onto and can use it as a reminder to always seek God's word.

What you will need: Paper, colouring pencils, glue and 2 straws/old pencils.



- 1. Draw your favourite bible story on your piece of a4 paper.
- 2. Set a straw (or old pencil) on each side of your piece of paper.
- 3. Glue down your straws and leave to dry.
- 4. Once dried, roll each side of your scroll half way so that they meet in the middle.
- 5. If you have ribbon or string, you could tie it around to hold it in place.

PHILIP AND THE ETHIOPIAN


Read Acts 8:26-40. Match the question with the answer on the right.
