Bible Story:

"Heroes of Faith" based on Hebrews 11 (https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=OlgXVihi_S8) is the series that Kids Church are going to focus on over the summer! We will learn about a different person from Hebrews 11 who demonstrated faith and this week we are focussing on Abel. Watch the video below and read Genesis 4:2-5.

In this passage in Genesis, two brothers give different offerings to God. Hebrews 11:4 says "By faith Abel offered to God a better sacrifice than Cain." God accepted Abel's offering but not Cain's because of different motivations. The heart of Abel's gift was faith which was not the case for Cain. If he had the right intentions, it might have been accepted.

How does this story help us today?

Cain and Abel both gave God something different, but God accepted the offering based on intentions. What we have to offer might look different from others, but God wants us to do our best. We can give God our time, our service, our love and more. As long as we give these things with faith, God is going to cherish each offering! Our challenge to you this week is to think of what you have to offer to God (if you don't think you have anything, you need to think harder). Think about how your offering is given to God, is it out of faith and love? Or do you have a different motivation behind it?

In this series it's important to remember that each person is a hero of faith but they still have flaws. Jesus is the ultimate hero of faith and is the only one who is perfect. But the great thing is that God uses imperfect people to teach us and Abel taught us to give with a faithful and grateful heart.

Craft:

Every superhero has a logo or a sign that is recognisable (see pictures below). We want you to get your creative hats on and create a new one.

What you will need: Paper, felt tips or colouring pencils and scissors.
