# **Bible Story:**

For the month of May, we are going to learn about parables in the bible. We are looking at the Parable of the Sower which can be found in Matthew 13:1-23. Read the story and watch the video below:

If you are like Ben and you enjoy planting sunflowers, or anything that you are able to grow, you will know that the type of ground that a seed is scattered on is very important. The parable today shows us what happens when a seed lands on four different types of ground. The seed in our lives is God's word and the four areas of land are examples of how our hearts respond to God's word.


Path: We hear God's word but don't react or do anything with it, our hearts are hard. Rocky Ground: There is no strong foundation and God's word does not grow in our life. Thorns: We listen and accept God's word but get caught up in the distractions of the world. Good Soil: Our hearts have listened and accepted God's word and because we have strong roots or foundations, we grow up strong and produce fruit.

The Sower in this parable is willing to scatter the seeds on any ground. God is the sower and He will scatter His word for everyone, but it is up to us how it grows in our life.

## **Craft:**

Today you are going to create your very own story book to remind you to read and understand God's word. Writing and drawing will help you to understand the story.

What you will need: Paper/Card, colouring pencils, scissors and cello tape/glue/stapler.



- 1. Cut your A4 paper/card into four rectangles.
- 2. Draw the areas that the farmer scattered the seeds: Path, rocky ground, thorns and good soil. Be creative! Make sure to leave a bit of space on the left of the page where the book will be stuck together.
- 3. Get a new piece of paper/card and cut into four rectangles (only two are needed).
- 4. With one of the rectangles, create your front cover. Be creative!
- 5. With the other rectangle, write out what it means for us if the seed falls on the path, rocky ground, thorns and good soil.
- 6. Now get your glue/stapler/cello tape and put the book together, using the small gap on the left of each rectangle to stick together.
