

Car Park Policy

1. Cars are parked at their owners' risk.
2. Access to the car park is gained by the Wardsborough Road entrance only.
3. Renters of commercial spaces are only permitted to use their own space, shown by their space number, between 8am and 6pm Monday to Saturday.
4. Church members should not park in reserved commercial spaces (as indicated by space number) between 8am to 6pm Monday to Saturday.
5. Spaces reserved for "Staff" should not be used by either church members or commercial users.
6. In respect to the car park, church members are defined as contributors to Free Will Offering.
7. No obstruction should be caused in any part of the car park and disabled spaces should be respected by all car park users.
8. Overnight parking by commercial users is not permitted for security reasons.
9. All drivers must always exercise extreme caution, obeying a speed limit of 5mph.
10. All rental fees apply to the full calendar year and must be paid by 31st January. Fobs will be cancelled if payment is not received by this date. Payment by instalment is only permitted by prior agreement with the Car Park Convenors.
11. Car park fobs are not transferrable.
12. The Kirk Session and Congregational Committee reserve the right to restrict access to the car park for all users when a wedding, funeral, conference, or other special event is taking place on church premises.

Annual Car Park Fees

Annual car park fees are currently as follows:

Commercial Users

- Standard Commercial space - £500

Congregational Members under 65

- One fob - £80
- 2 fobs for two family members - £120

Congregational Members aged 65 or over

- One fob - £40
- 2 fobs (both members 65 or over) - £60
- 2 fobs (one member 65 or over and the other member under 65) - £90

Congregational Members Non-Casual parking

- 5/6 days per week - £250
- 3/4 days per week - £200
- 1/2 days per week - £150

Replacement fob - £20

Annual Payment Process

Please complete the annual Renewal Form and place in an envelope on the collection plate, leave in church caretaker's post box or hand to the Car Park Convenor. If not paying by bank transfer payment should be returned with the Renewal Form.
